**SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- July 2021**

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**KEY ACTIVITIES**

**STATUS**

- **WWTP Facility** Effluent flows: Effluent flows: 34.67 million gallons were treated during July. The highest Daily flow was 1.37 million gallons on the 22<sup>nd</sup> and the lowest flow was 0.90 million gallons on the 11<sup>th</sup>. The average flow was 1.12 million gallons. Total rainfall for July was 0.02 inches. 196 yards of bio-solids were given away in July.
- **WTP** Highest production day was 4,073,000 gallons on July 24<sup>th</sup>.
- **Water System** Replaced 11 water meters. Cleaned number 1 filter bed.
- **Streets** Swept 125 curb miles and 16 cubic yards of material was collected. Replaced 9 regulatory and 1 guide signs.
- **Parks** None for July 2021.
