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ORDINANCE NO. 201.

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT OF COSTS UPON CONVICTION OF VIOLATION OF ANY ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF STAYTON: PROVIDING FOR IMPRISONMENT UPON FAILURE TO PAY ANY FINE ASSESSED FOR VIOLATION OF ANY ORDINANCE; and PROVIDING FOR THE WORKING OF PERSONS SENTENCED TO PRISONMENT UPON VIOLATION OF ANY ORDINANCE.

THE TOWN OF STAYTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Whenever any person or persons shall be convicted of any violation of any Ordinance now or hereafter in effect in the Town of Stayton, the costs and disbursements of such proceeding may be assessed against such person or persons, in addition to the sentence of fine and/or imprisonment.

Section 2, Whenever any person or persons shall be sentenced to pay a fine upon conviction for violation of any ordinance now or hereafter in effect in the Town of Stayton, such sentence shall also provide that such person or persons shall be imprisoned until such fine be satisfied, for a length of time not to exceed one day of imprisonment for every \$2.00 of the fine.

Section 3, Whenever any person or persons shall be sentenced to imprisonment upon conviction for the violation of any Ordinance now or hereafter in effect in the Town of Stayton, such sentence may provide that such person or persons be required to work upon the streets of the Town, or at any other work on behalf of the Town.

Section 4, All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed; provided that all Ordinances and parts of ordinances hereby repealed, shall remain in full force and effect for punishment of all violations thereof, committed prior to the time of adoption of this Ordinance.

Section 5, Whereas there is no Ordinance now in force providing for the Assessment of costs upon conviction of violation of any Ordinance, It is the judgement of this Council that an emergency exists, and that it is necessary for the peace, good order and safety of the Town of Stayton that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
