

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN OFFICERS.

Ord. 261*

The town of Stayton do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The recorder shall receive as compensation for services performed by him in such capacity the sum of \$20 per month.

Section 2. The marshal shall receive as compensation for services performed by him in such capacity, including services performed by him as water superintendent and street commissioner, the sum of \$125 per month.

Section 3. The attorney shall receive as compensation for services performed by him in such capacity such amount as may be allowed by the council on bills rendered each month for services performed by said attorney.

Section 4. The salaries provided for in this ordinance shall be paid in the same manner as other claims against the town of Stayton are paid.
