

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE CONSTRUCTION, USE AND OPERATION OF GASOLINE AND OIL PUMPS AND GASOLINE TANKS.

The Town of Stayton do ordain as follows:

Section 1. No gasoline or oil pump or tank shall be constructed, placed or erected upon any street, alley or walk without first having obtained a permit so to do from the ~~City~~ Council. Such permit shall show the particular place and purpose for which such pump or tank is to be used.

Section 2. The owner or operator of any gasoline or oil pump or tank shall immediately, upon vacating or ceasing to use or operate such pump or tank, remove the same and restore the street, alley, or walk to as good condition as circumstances will permit.

Section 3. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of an offense, and upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than \$5 nor more than \$100, or by imprisonment of not less than 2 days nor more than 50 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the court.
