

ORDINANCE NO. 291

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING SET BACK REGULATIONS FROM PROPERTY LINES AND OTHER BUILDINGS FOR DWELLINGS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Be it Ordained by the Common Council of the Town of Stayton:

Section 1. No person or firm shall build or commence to build a residential building or detached building in the Town of Stayton unless said residential building or detached building shall be set back at least 18 feet from the street boundary.

Section 2. No person or firm shall build a residential building or detached building unless the same shall be four feet from any adjacent property line.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary immediately for the public, health, peace and safety of the Town of Stayton, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage by the council and approval by the mayor.
