

ORDINANCE NO. 865

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING STAYTON MUNICIPAL CODE ORDINANCE NO. 759 WHICH IS RELATED TO INVENTORY SEARCHES BY THE STAYTON POLICE DEPARTMENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council adopted Ordinance No. 759 on April 16, 1996, which is an ordinance related to establishing procedures for inventory searches by the Stayton Police Department.

WHEREAS, this ordinance was never assimilated into Stayton Municipal Code.

WHEREAS, subsequently Ordinance No. 862 "An Ordinance establishing procedures for Inventory Searches by the Stayton Police Department; and declaring an emergency" was adopted on April 05, 2004, and supercedes the terms and succeeds the force and effect of Ordinance 759; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate Ordinance No. 759 be repealed;

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that an emergency be declared as to the enactment of this Ordinance so that it is in full force and effect immediately from and after its adoption by the Stayton City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Stayton City Council hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1.

Ordinance No. 759 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2.

An emergency is hereby declared and, upon adoption by the Stayton City Council and the mayor's signing, this Ordinance shall become immediately effective.
