

ORDINANCE NO. 745

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING STAYTON MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 2.34, "TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE," TO PERMIT THE APPOINTMENT OF ONE MEMBER FROM OUTSIDE THE CITY.

WHEREAS, Stayton Municipal Code Title 2. charges the Stayton Transportation Committee with identification, prioritization, and financing options of street related construction projects, capital improvement projects, and long-range planning for consideration by the Stayton City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Stayton City Council believes that the committee and the city is best served by members who possess an interest and expertise in street-related issues; and

WHEREAS, an individual having the desired interest and expertise may reside outside the city limits of the City of Stayton;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Stayton City Council hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: Stayton Municipal Code Section 2.34.860 is hereby amended to read:

2.34.860 **TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE: APPOINTMENT AND TERMS OF OFFICE**

1. The Stayton Transportation Committee shall consist of one council person and five members, all of whom are appointed from the community at large (but one of whom may be appointed from outside the city limits), who shall serve from January 1st in the year of their appointment by the mayor. The mayor shall also appoint a council liaison to serve as a non-voting member of the Transportation Committee.
2. One member of the committee shall initially hold office for one (1) year, two members shall hold office for two (2) years, and two members shall hold office for three (3) years. At the expiration of any member's term, the mayor shall appoint a new member or may reappoint a member for a three-year term. If a vacancy occurs, the mayor shall appoint a new member for the unexpired term.
3. No person shall hold appointment as a member for more than two (2) full consecutive terms, but any person may be appointed again to the committee after an interval of one (1) year.
4. Vacancies and Removal: Appointment to fill vacancies shall be for the remainder of the unexpired term. A member may be removed by the mayor and council for misconduct or non-performance of duty. A member who is absent for three (3) consecutive meetings without an excused absence approved by the Transportation Committee shall be presumed to be in nonperformance of duty and the mayor and city council shall declare the position vacant. A judgment of misconduct or nonperformance of duty shall be made in writing from the Transportation Committee to the mayor and council.
