

ORDINANCE NUMBER 408

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING PORTIONS OF ORDINANCE  
NUMBER 384 OF THE CITY OF STAYTON

THE CITY OF STAYTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Ordinance Number 384 entitled "An Ordinance Providing for the Construction, Improvement and Acceptance of Streets Within the City of Stayton; Repealing Ordinance Number 292; and Declaring an Emergency," is hereby amended as follows:

- a. Section 4, Subsection B, of Ordinance Number 384 is hereby repealed.
- b. Section 5, of Ordinance Number 384 is hereby amended to read "Before any street improvements shall be made, the abutting owner or his representative shall notify the City Engineer or Street Superintendent, who shall supply, at City expense, the grade lines and specifications for the clearing and grading of the street. In the event such improvements are not commenced within six months, the owner shall reimburse the City for such engineering expense.
- c. Section 6, of Ordinance Number 384 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be so interpreted as to be retroactive to the enactment date of Ordinance Number 384, and the City of Stayton shall be responsible for any storm drainage charges incurred thereunder.
