Providing the form of poll book to be used at the special city election of the City of Stayton to be held May 4, 1965, and declaring an emergency.

THE CITY OF STAYTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The poll book to be used at the special city election of the City of Stayton, Oregon to be held on May 4, 1965, shall be of the form submitted by the County Clerk of the County of Marion, State of Oregon for use at general biennial elections of the State of Oregon.

Section 2. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the City of Stayton and the inhabitant thereof and an emergency hereby is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approved by the Mayor.
