

ORDINANCE NO. 352


AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF ORDINANCE NO. 264 RELATING TO DIVISION OF THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON, INTO ZONES, PRESCRIBING THE USES TO WHICH PROPERTY IN SUCH ZONES MAY BE PUT OR USED, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

The City of Stayton does ordain as follows:


