ORDINANCE NO. 396

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 326
OF THE CITY OF STAYTON TO PROVIDE A
SANITARY SEWER BILL DEPOSIT.

The City of Stayton do ordain as follows:

SECTION I.

Section 4 of Ordinance No. 326 of the City of Stayton, entitled "An Ordinance Establishing Sewer Rates and Charges for the City of Stayton Sewer System, Making Said Charges a Lien on the Property Served, Pledging the Net Revenues Therefrom for Operation, Maintenance, and Debt Retirement, and Declaring an Emergency" and enacted September 9, 1963, is hereby amended to read:

SECTION IV.

a. In the event of failure of payment for the services, the City shall have the right to discontinue water service to the premises and the said delinquent sewer charge, after application of the deposit provided for herein, shall become and constitute a lien against the premises and shall be enforced accordingly.

b. A deposit equal to three months estimated sewer bill shall be paid by each new customer to be held as security for the payment of any account to become owing for water or sewer use. At such time as the depositing customer shall cease to use the service, or at any other time the Council may by motion direct, any balance of the deposit shall be refunded. Any deposit unclaimed by a customer for one year or more shall be forfeited to the City.

SECTION II.

This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and welfare, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and signature by the Mayor.


