

ORDINANCE NO. 500

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL ELECTORS OF THE CITY A PROPOSITION AUTHORIZING A LEVY BY THE CITY OF A TAX IN THE SUM OF \$330,390.30 OUTSIDE THE CONSTITUTIONAL LIMITATIONS FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF ALL DEPARTMENTS OF THE GENERAL FUND TO BE HELD MAY 23, 1978; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Stayton, Oregon, has determined that a tax levy should be established as authorized by Section II, Article XI, Oregon Constitution for the tax year 1978-79, to provide funds for the operation and maintenance of departments of the General Fund.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to submit the question of tax in excess of the six percent (6%) constitutional limitations in the form of a tax levy.

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY OF STAYTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Date of Election. The proposition set forth in Section 2 of this Ordinance shall be submitted in the manner prescribed herein to the legal voters of the City of Stayton, Oregon, at the primary election to be held on May 23, 1978.

Section 2. Form of Proposition. At the primary election there shall be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Stayton for their approval or rejection, the following proposition:

"Shall the City of Stayton be authorized to levy a tax on

property in the sum of Three Hundred Thirty Thousand Three Hundred Ninety Dollars and Thirty Cents (\$330,390.30) outside the limitation imposed by Section II, Article XI, Oregon Constitution, for the tax year 1978-79, to provide funds for the operation and maintenance of departments of the General Fund?"

Section 3. That the polling places and the clerks for said election shall be the same as those for the primary election, and the Recorder is hereby instructed to post notices of such election in the manner provided by Ordinance No. 242 of such City, and to furnish to the Election Board of the County any necessary records, ballot box, tally sheets, and supplies. Such election shall be conducted in accordance with the election laws of the State of Oregon and with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Stayton.

Section 4. The following form of ballot title for such proposition is hereby adopted and approved:

Referred to the people by the City Council

ESTABLISHING A TAX LEVY. "Shall the City of Stayton be authorized to levy a tax on property in the sum of Three Hundred Thirty Thousand Three Hundred Ninety Dollars and Thirty Cents (\$330,390.30) outside the limitation imposed by Section II, Article XI, Oregon Constitution, for the tax year 1978-79, to provide funds for the operation and maintenance of departments of the General Fund?"

52 YES I vote for the Ordinance.

NO I vote against the Ordinance.

Section 5. Emergency Clause. This Ordinance being necessary for the securing of funds for the operation of the City, and necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, and safety, an emergency is declared and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its enactment.


