

ORDINANCE NO. 512

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING 1979 STAYTON COMPREHENSIVE PLAN.

WHEREAS; Oregon Revised Statues provides for cities to develop comprehensive land use policies consistant with state-wide goals, and;

WHEREAS; The Land Conservation and Development Commission and the City of Stayton have provided funds for the research and development of a Comprehensive Plan, and;

WHEREAS; The City of Stayton and its residents are desirous to have a Comprehensive Plan to insure future livability through managed growth and to conserve natural resources while creating a stable economic base;

NOW THEREFORE;

THE CITY OF STAYTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Adoption of the Stayton Comprehensive Plan. The City of Stayton hereby adopts by reference that certain document entitled "Stayton Comprehensive Plan 1979" that the City Council received on February 5, 1979, and ordered placed on file for public inspection in the Office of the Administrator, and that has since continuously been so on file and available for public inspection during regular working hours, as fully as if this ordinance set forth in full, the entire contents of the Comprehensive Plan.

Section 2. Saving Cause. This ordinance shall not affect:

1. Any offense or act committed or done, any penalty or forfeiture incurred, or any contract or right established or accruing before this ordnance is enacted;
2. Any ordinance relating to the boundaries of the City;
3. Any ordinance annexing territory to the City;
4. Any prosecution, suit or proceeding pending at the time this ordinance is enacted; or

5. Any judgment rendered prior to the time this ordinance is enacted.
Section 3. Emergency. This ordinance being necessary for the preservation of public peace, safety and welfare, shall become in full force from and on the date of its approval by the Common Council of the City of Stayton.
