

ORDINANCE No. 569

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING STAYTON CITY CODE SECTIONS RELATING TO THE LICENSING AND OPERATION OF AMUSEMENT DEVICES

WHEREAS, the present City Code Sections relating to amusement devices restricts operation by minors and prohibits the licensing of games of chance; and

IT APPEARING to the Stayton City Council that such provisions are no longer needed to protect public health, safety and welfare,

NOW THEREFORE

THE CITY OF STAYTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Stayton City Code Sections 3.400(6) and 3.405(1) relating to operation of amusement devices by minors, enacted January 12, 1976, are hereby repealed.

Section 2. Stayton City Code Section 3.400(3) is amended to repeal and strike the bracketed language as follows:

3. No license shall be issued for the sale, lease, distribution, placing, or operation of any amusement device which is reasonably intended for gambling [or for playing any game in which the element of chance predominates over the element of skill].

Section 3. This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance takes effect on its signing.
