

RESOLUTION NO. 931

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF STAYTON TO APPLY FOR A LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT FROM THE OREGON PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR REPLACEMENT OF THE PEDESTRIAN FOOTBRIDGE IN PIONEER PARK.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department (OPRD) is accepting applications for the Local Government Grant Program;

WHEREAS, the Stayton Park and Recreation Board has reviewed the need for a new footbridge in Pioneer Park;

WHEREAS, the Stayton Park and Recreation Board recommends the City apply for a Local Government grant from the OPRD.

WHEREAS, the OPRD grant program requires a 40 percent match and the City of Stayton desires to participate in this matching grant program to the greatest extent possible;

WHEREAS, one of the requirements of the OPRD grant application process is that the application must include a resolution from the governing body authorizing the grant application.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that


Section 1. The City of Stayton, through its City Administrator, shall apply for a Local Government Grant from the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department for a grant to pay for the replacement of the pedestrian footbridge in Pioneer Park.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption by the Stayton City Council.


