

RESOLUTION NO. 836

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CHANGES TO THE ADOPTED 2008-09 BUDGET

WHEREAS, after the budget process for the 2008-2009 Fiscal Year, additional capital outlay projects have been awarded for both the Sewer and Water Fund;

WHEREAS, The award of contracts for pump replacement at the Sewer Plant, and water main replacement for the Water Distribution System.

WHEREAS, These projects are more than \$5,000.00 and will extend the life of the Sewer and Water Systems by more than one year, therefore classified as Capital Outlay expenses; and,

WHEREAS, in order to lawfully comply with the requirements of Local Budget Law, a transfer of appropriation is necessary.

WHEREAS, Oregon Revised Statutes 294.450 allows for the transfer of appropriations decreasing an existing appropriation in a fund and increasing an existing appropriation in the same fund.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council wishes to comply with Local Budget Law and transfer existing appropriations within the same fund; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a transfer should be made in the Sewer Fund reducing Material and Services in the amount of \$250,000 and increasing Capital Outlay in the Sewer Fund in the amount of \$250,000, transfer in the Water fund reducing Materials and Services in the amount of \$135,000 and increasing Capitol Outlay in the Water Fund in the amount of \$135,000; and,

This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption by the Stayton City Council.


