

RESOLUTION NO. 869

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CHANGES TO THE ADOPTED 2010-11 BUDGET

WHEREAS, after the budget process for the 2010-2011 Fiscal Year, The Water Enterprise fund must increase appropriations in Capital Outlay;

WHEREAS, In order for the City to make repairs to High Street, replacement of the under sized water lines was necessary; and,

WHEREAS, in order to lawfully comply with the requirements of Local Budget Law, a transfer of appropriation is necessary.

WHEREAS, Oregon Revised Statutes 294.450 allows for the transfer of appropriations decreasing an existing appropriation in a fund and increasing an existing appropriation in the same fund.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council wishes to comply with Local Budget Law and transfer existing appropriations within the same fund; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a transfer should be made in the Water Enterprise Fund increasing Capital Outlay in the amount of \$30,000 and decreasing Materials and Services in the Street SDC Fund in the amount of \$30,000; and,

This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption by the Stayton City Council.
