

RESOLUTION No. 626

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF A RECOVERY 28% GOAL FOR MARION COUNTY.

WHEREAS; The State of Oregon has adopted a goal of recovering 50% of its solid waste by the year 2000 in order to preserve resources and protect the environment of Oregon and the Nations and;

WHEREAS; In order to meet this goal all citizens need to increase their efforts to reduce waste, reuse, and recycle. The legislature has required that cities and counties work together to adopt a new local recovery goal which will help the state reach the goal of 50% and;

WHEREAS; The legislation has placed no penalties or requirements on the achievement of this goal and;

WHEREAS; Marion County has recently adopted a Solid Waste Plan after extensive public input which set a goal of 35% recovery of waste by the year 2000.




