

RESOLUTION No. 636

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE OREGON LAND CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION SCHEDULE STAYTON'S COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AND DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE FOR PERIODIC REVIEW NOTICE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

WHEREAS, the Stayton Comprehensive Plan and Development Ordinance were last acknowledged by the Land Conservation and Development Commission in April of 1991; and

WHEREAS, Oregon jurisdictions are to conduct a periodic review of their Comprehensive Plans every seven to ten years; and


WHEREAS, the dated 1991 Stayton Comprehensive Plan and Development Ordinance do not comply with several statewide planning goals, statutes, and administrative rules that have been established since the Plan's acknowledgment; and


WHEREAS, the dated 1991 Stayton Comprehensive Plan and Development Ordinance have caused coordination problems with Marion County; and

WHEREAS, the dated 1991 Stayton Comprehensive Plan and Development Ordinance do not effectively provide for the community identity and growth management that is desired by Stayton residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Stayton that we request that the Land Conservation and Development Commission schedule the Stayton Comprehensive Plan and Development Ordinance for periodic review notice as soon as possible, and that we encourage Stayton planning staff to work together with representatives of the Department of Land Conservation and Development to develop and carry out a comprehensive work program once notice is received.
