

RESOLUTION NO. 690

A RESOLUTION SETTLING THE TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM DEVELOPMENT CHARGE RELATING TO SIAM HOUSE RESTAURANT.

WHEREAS, the City of Stayton has established a methodology to determine transportation system development charges when appropriate;

WHEREAS, the City of Stayton gave notice to the Siam House Restaurant an assessment of \$4,089.60, the calculation based on the "prior use" being a hardware store; and

WHEREAS, on appeal, heard March 19, 2001, the Stayton City Council, after deliberation, found that as the "prior use" was a restaurant, determined that the \$4,089.60 transportation system development charge should be rescinded.

NOW THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED by the Stayton City Council that there shall be no transportation system development charge assessed to Siam House Restaurant.
