

RESOLUTION NO. 591

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE CITY'S POLICY PROHIBITING PLACEMENT OF SIGNS, PLACARDS, BILLS, OR POSTERS ON CITY-OWNED PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, the Stayton Municipal Code (Section 8.04.150) establishes a policy directing that the placement of signs, placards, bills, or posters on real property, public or private, must have the consent of the owner of the property or of the proper public authority; and

WHEREAS, the Stayton City Council finds that the placement of signs, in any form, on city-owned property by any non-governmental entity is undesirable.

NOW, THEREFORE, the city council of the City of Stayton hereby resolves that the placement of signs, placards, bills, or posters on city-owned property, including public rights-of-way, by any non-governmental entity shall be prohibited.
