

RESOLUTION NO. 449

A RESOLUTION TO PROTECT OREGON JOBS AND ENSURE THE LONG TERM HEALTH AND PRODUCTIVITY OF OREGON'S FOREST PRODUCTS INDUSTRY.

WHEREAS, the State of Oregon's largest employer is the forestry, lumber, and wood products industry; and

WHEREAS, forest products industries have reached a point of crisis; and

WHEREAS, we recognize that the forest products industry is a key component in the North Santiam Canyon and Stayton economies; and

WHEREAS, we appreciate the forest products industry's presence and valued contributions to our community's economic health and vitality; and


WHEREAS, the State of Oregon's rural communities, families, workers, schools, and our statewide economic vitality are strengthened by all reasonable steps being taken to protect jobs and the long term health and productivity of the forest products industry; and

WHEREAS, protecting Oregon forest products industries is an issue for not only the federal legislature, but for the state legislature as well.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Stayton that representatives of the forest products industry and the Oregon State Legislature are urged to work together with federal officials to immediately address and resolve the critical issues facing Oregon's forest products industry.
