

RESOLUTION NO. 482

A RESOLUTION CERTIFYING CITY OF STAYTON'S ELIGIBILITY TO RECEIVE STATE-SHARED REVENUES (CIGARETTE, LIQUOR, AND HIGHWAY TAXES) BY PROVIDING THE NECESSARY MUNICIPAL SERVICES.

WHEREAS, ORS 221.760, Section 1., provides that the officer responsible for disbursing funds to the cities under ORS 323.455, 366.785 to 366.820, and 471.805 shall, in the case of the city located within a county having more than 100,000 inhabitants according to the most recent federal decennial census, disburse such funds only if the city provides four (4) or more of the following services:

1. Police protection
2. Fire protection
3. Street construction, maintenance, and lighting
4. Sanitary sewers
5. Storm sewers
6. Planning, zoning, and subdivision control
7. One or more utility services; and

WHEREAS, city officials recognize the desirability of assisting the state office responsible for determining the eligibility of cities to receive such funds in accordance with ORS 221.760;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Stayton hereby certifies that it provides the following municipal services enumerated in Section 1, ORS 221.760:

1. Police protection
2. Street construction, maintenance, and lighting
3. Sanitary sewers
4. Storm sewers
5. Planning, zoning, and subdivision control
6. Water service
