

RESOLUTION NO. 251

A RESOLUTION RESTRICTING THE USE OF WEST IDA STREET.

WHEREAS, West Ida Street was recently improved, by paving with asphaltic concrete, from the west City limits to Evergreen Street, and;

WHEREAS, the City has received complaints concerning the use of said street by vehicles weighing or hauling loads in excess of those recommended, and;

WHEREAS, the City is concerned that the continued use by heavy weighted vehicles will reduce the life of said street and require maintenance sooner than is normally necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE;


THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STAYTON RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Ida Street, from First Avenue to the west City limits, shall be restricted from use by those vehicles in excess of 30,000 pounds gross weight (15 ton). These weight limits shall not be applicable to use of Ida Street by emergency vehicles or to vehicles making deliveries to property which is accessible only from Ida Street. The limits on weight shall be posted, along West Ida Street, in accordance with standards for highway signing and the Police Department of the City of Stayton, is hereby authorized to enforce said posted weight limits in accordance with Stayton Code, Section 7.180 and Oregon Revised Statutes, Section 487.905.
