

RESOLUTION NUMBER 110

Ordering construction of curbs in Green Acres Park Addition, Stayton, Oregon.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON:

The Common Council hereby declares it to be necessary and expedient that new curbs be constructed within the corporate limits of the City of Stayton, Oregon, and located within the Green Acres Park Addition, adjacent to and abutting upon all front pieces or parcels of real property located as follows:

- East side of lot 14, block 1, owned by S.E. & J.I. Mayo.
- East side and north side of lot 15, block 1, owned by L. A. Drushella.
- North side of lot 16, block 1, owned by F.A. & L.J. Lulay.
- North side of lot 2, block 2, owned by U. & F. Crowson. *as*
- North side of lot 1, block 2, owned by ~~Wanda & Jess Ingram.~~ *as*
- South side of lot 4, block 4, owned by E. & L. Jacoby.
- South side and East side of lot 1, block 5, owned by E. & L. Jacoby.
- South side of lot 1, block 6, owned by L. & L. Burns.

The curbs ordered constructed by this resolution shall be built of Portland Cement Concrete as provided by ordinance number 300, and shall be laid down and constructed at the expense of the lot or parcel of land involved. Such curbs shall be completed within 90 days from the date of mailing of notice by the city recorder to the owner of said property of the adoption of this resolution. The recorder shall give notice by mail to the owner of said property requiring such owner to construct the said curb as herein ordered; and in case the address of the owner be unknown, the city engineer shall post such notice upon said property. Before constructing such curb, the owner of said premises or his agent, shall obtain a permit from the city, which permit shall prescribe the kind of curb to be constructed, the material to be used, and the specifications therefor.

In case the owner of the property shall fail to construct the curb as hereby ordered, and within the time limit above specified, the Common Council shall take steps to bring about the construction of such curb and make the cost thereof a lien upon the property involved.
