

RESOLUTION NUMBER 130

Ordering construction of a 4 foot sidewalk and curb on the South side of West Washington Street in the City of Stayton along the North side of that tract of land conveyed to H.L. and N.R. Fleming by deed recorded in Volume 579, Page 287, deed records of Marion County, Oregon, and located at 520 West Washington Street, Stayton, Oregon.


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON:

The Common Council hereby declares it to be necessary and expedient that a 4 foot sidewalk and curb be constructed within the corporate limits of the City of Stayton, Oregon, upon and along the South side of West Washington Street against the abutting and adjacent property more specifically described as that tract of land conveyed to H. L. and N. R. Fleming by deed recorded in Volume 579, Page 287, deed records of Marion County, Oregon, and located at 520 West Washington Street, Stayton, Oregon.

The 4 foot sidewalk and curb ordered constructed by this resolution shall be built of Portland Cement Concrete as provided by Ordinance Number 300, and shall be laid down and constructed at the expense of the lot or parcel of land involved. Such 4 foot sidewalk and curb shall be completed within 30 days from the date of notice to the property owner. The recorder shall give notice by mail to the owner of said property requiring such owner to construct the said 4 foot sidewalk and curb as herein ordered. Before constructing such 4 foot sidewalk and curb, the owner of said premises or his agent, shall obtain plans and specifications from the city engineer, which shall prescribe the kind of 4 foot sidewalk and curb to be constructed, the material to be used, and the specifications therefore.

In case the owner of the property shall fail to construct the 4 foot sidewalk and curb as hereby ordered, and within the time limit above specified, the Common Council shall take steps to bring about the construction of such 4 foot sidewalk and curb and make the cost thereof a lien upon the property involved.
