

RESOLUTION ORDERING CONSTRUCTION

OF SIDEWALKS AND CURBS

CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON

Resolution No. 71

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON:

Section 1. The Common Council hereby declares it to be necessary and expedient that a new sidewalk and curb be constructed within the corporate limits of the City of Stayton, Oregon, upon and along the North side of Locust Street between North Douglas Avenue and North First Avenue adjacent to and abutting upon that certain piece or parcel of real property owned by Raymond and Marjorie Kerber and described as follows, to-wit:

Raymond D. and Marjorie E. Kerber

Beginning at a point 30.00 feet North and 8.332 chains West of the middle point of Section 10, Township 9 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian in Marion County, Oregon: thence North 4.163 chains; thence West to the Northeast corner of a tract of land conveyed to Harold Freres and wife by deed recorded in Volume 574, Page 725, Deed Records for the Marion County, Oregon; thence South 4.163 chains to the Southeast corner of a tract of land conveyed to Ted Highberger and wife by deed recorded in Volume 523, Page 773, said deed records; thence East 238.73 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.


Section 2. The sidewalk and curb ordered constructed by this resolution shall be build of Portland Cement Concrete as provided by ordinance, and shall be laid down and constructed at the expense of the lot or parcel of land described in Section 1 hereof. Such walk and curbs shall be completed within 30 days from the date of mailing of notice by the city recorder to the owner of said property of the adoption of this resolution.

The recorder shall give notice by mail to the owner of said property, requiring such owner to construct the said sidewalk and curb as herein ordered; and in case the address of the owner be unknown, the city engineer shall post such notice upon said property. Before constructing such walk and curb, the owner of said premises or his agent, shall obtain a permit from the city, which permit shall prescribe the kine of sidewalk and curb to be constructed, the material to be used, and the specifications therefor.

Section 3. In case the owner of the property shall fail to construct the sidewalk and curb as hereby ordered, and within the time limit above specified, the Common Council shall take steps to bring about the construction of such sidewalk and curb and make the cost thereof a lien upon the property above described.
