RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STAYTON, OREGON: Be it remembered that at a meeting of the Common Council of the Town of Stayton, Oregon held this 7th day of January, 1952, the following action was taken.

That whereas pursuant to a request of the employees of the Town of Stayton an election was held amongest such employees for the purpose of determining whether or not a majority of the employees desire to make application or become a part of the Social Security Program of the Federal Government, and

That such election results were 6 employees voting yes. There were no employees voting no.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STAYTON, OREGON

Section 1. That pursuant to request of the majority of the employees of the Town of Stayton, Oregon it is hereby resolved that the Common Council of the Town of Stayton direct the City Recorder to make all necessary applications and prepare all forms and secure approval of the public employees retirement system and the Federal Social Security program for coverage of the employees of the Town of Stayton.

Section 2. City Recorder is directed and authorized to secure all necessary vouchers and papers and bring to a successful conclusion the application of the Council of Stayton for Social Security coverage for its employees.
