RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STAYTON, OREGON

BE IT REMEMBERED that at a meeting of the common council of the Town of Stayton, Marion County, Oregon held on the 4th day of August, 1952, the following action was taken.

The matter of the sale of
the City Dump **Grounds**

RESOLVED: That whereas the common Council of the Town of Stayton has deemed it necessary to sell the herein described property, known as the City Dump. That the City Dump Grounds having been condemned for further use and that the same should be disposed of and the money place in the general fund for caring for the current obligations and present programs.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STAYTON, OREGON

That the Common Council of the Town of Stayton do hereby resolve that the property known as the City Dump Grounds be sold to _____ Jack R. Taggert and Henrietta M. Taggert for the sum of Three Thousand and no/100 DOLLARS and it is hereby further ordered that the City Recorder pay title insurance to complete the transaction and that said transaction shall be with the aid of the City Attorney.
