A word from Mayor Vigil...

Over the past several months, you may have noticed several exciting projects happening at Santiam Park. Major components have included new rubberized playground surfacing, a picnic shelter, restroom building, additional street lighting, and a parking area. The project is expected to be complete by mid-October.

This project was made possible by grants from the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department, the A.J. Frank Family Foundation, and the Doris J. Wipper Fund of the Oregon Community Foundation. Also, many local contractors contributed including Bethel Excavation, Slayden Construction Group, Inc., Blazer Industries, Campbell Crane, Crawford Electric, Knife River, North Santiam Paving, Stayton Builders Mart, and Top Notch Construction.
