**SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- August 2023**

**KEY ACTIVITIES**

**STATUS**

- **WWTP Facility** Effluent flows: 34.09 million gallons were treated during Aug. The highest Daily flow was 1.15 million gallons on the 12th and the lowest flow was 0.71 million gallons on the 19th. The average flow was 0.85 million gallons. Total rainfall for Aug. was .62 inches. 123 yards of bio solids were applied on site in Aug.
- **WTP** Highest production day was 3,528,000 gallons on August 19, 2023.
- **Water System** Replaced 17 meters. Replaced 2 meter boxes and repaired 2 water main lines.
- **Streets** Swept 120 curb miles and 25 cubic yards of material was collected. 2 yards of gravel applied to gravel roads.
- **Parks** Nothing to report.
