SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- May 2022

KEY ACTIVITIES

STATUS

- **WWTP Facility** Effluent flows: 58.19 million gallons were treated during May. The highest Daily flow was 2.48 million gallons on the 7th and the lowest flow was 1.25 million gallons on the 28th. The average flow was 1.88 million gallons. Total rainfall for May was 5.95 inches. 46 yards of bio solids were hauled off site in May.
- **WTP** Highest production day was 3,629,000 gallons on May 27, 2022. Slow Sand Filter Bed 2 was resanded and the project is 97% complete.
- **Water System** Replaced 14 water meters. Replaced 4-meter boxes and 5 water service lines.
- **Streets** Swept 75 curb miles and 8 cubic yards of material was collected. 10 cubic yards of sweeping material hauled off to Coffin Butte.
- **Parks** None for May 2022.
