SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- November 2022

KEY ACTIVITIES

STATUS

- **WWTP Facility** Effluent flows: 45.22 million gallons were treated during November. The highest Daily flow was 2.58 million gallons on the 8th and the lowest flow was 0.99 million gallons on the 25th. The average flow was 1.38 million gallons. Total rainfall for November was 9.03 inches. No bio solids were hauled off site in November.
- **WTP** Highest production day was 3,146,000 gallons on November 03, 2022.
- **Water System** Replaced 3 meters.
- **Streets** Swept 280 curb miles and 67 cubic yards of material was collected.
- **Parks** None for November 2022.
