**SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- October 2020**

KEY ACTIVITIES

STATUS

- **WWTP Facility** Effluent flows: 35.32 million gallons were treated during October. The highest Daily flow was 1.37 million gallons on October 13<sup>th</sup> and the lowest flow was 0.92 million gallons on the 4<sup>th</sup>. The average flow was 1.14 million gallons. Total rainfall for October was 2.60 inches. 20.64 dry tons of bio solids were produced. 0 yards of bio solids were used for lawn fertilizer at the WWTP and 0 yards of Santiam Green was picked up by local citizens in October.
- **WTP** Highest production day was 2,623,000 gallons on October 1<sup>st</sup>.
- **Water System** Replaced 18 water meters. Water service replacements at 1536 & 1538 Westfield PL. Repaired service line at 1930 Fern. Replaced three meter boxes.
- **Streets** Swept 443 curb miles and 76 cubic yards of material was collected. Replaced all street signs in Industrial area with MUTCD standard signs. Sink hole repair at Kent Ct.
- **Parks** None for October 2020.
