SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- September 2022

KEY ACTIVITIES

STATUS

- **WWTP Facility** Effluent flows: 32.25 million gallons were treated during September. The highest Daily flow was 1.24 million gallons on the 2nd and the lowest flow was 0.96 million gallons on the 17th & 18th. The average flow was .90 million gallons. Total rainfall was 0.30 inches. 125 yards of bio solids were hauled off site in September.
- **WTP** Highest production day was 3,831,000 gallons on September 08, 2022.
- **Water System** Replaced 18 meters. Replaced 1 meter box. Repaired 1 water meter main and 1 water service line. Replaced 1 water service line.
- **Streets** Swept 132 curb miles and 17 cubic yards of material was collected.
- **Parks** None for September 2022.
