

AN ORDINANCE to Amend Ordinance No. 245 Fixing the Salaries of certain Officers.

THE TOWN OF STAYTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 245 entitled "An Ordinance Fixing the Salaries of Certain Officers," and passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor of the Town of Stayton on April 20, 1942, be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

Section 1. The Recorder shall receive as compensation for services performed by him in such capacity the sum of \$20.00 per month, and in addition thereto the same fees as are now allowed a justice of the peace for like services.

Section 2. The Marshal shall receive as compensation for services performed by him in such capacity, including services performed by him as Water Superintendent and Street Commissioner, the sum of \$150.00 per month.

Section 3. The Treasurer shall receive as compensation for services performed by him in such capacity the sum of \$10.00 per month.

Section 4. The attorney for the Town shall receive as compensation for services performed by him in such capacity such amount as may be allowed by the Council on bills rendered each month for services performed by him.

Section 5. The rates of compensation herein provided shall be effective as of and from July 1, 1942.

Section 6. The salaries and compensation provided herein shall be paid in the same manner as other claims against the Town are paid.
