

ORDINANCE NO. 265

AN ORDINANCE to regulate the use and sale of fireworks within the Town of Stayton; to provide penalties for a violation hereof; and to repeal conflicting ordinances.

THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF STAYTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The term "Fireworks" as used in this ordinance, shall mean and include all firecrackers, skyrockets, pinwheels, cap guns, and all other articles and devices of a combustible and/or explosive nature which are commonly used for amusement purposes.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to set off or explode or cause to be set off or exploded, sale or offer to seller cause to be sold within the Town of Stayton, Oregon, any fireworks herein defined, except on the days of July 2, 3, 4 and 5 in any year; provided that the Council may by resolution, authorize the use of fireworks at other times.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any person to set off or explode any fireworks in a manner to endanger any person or property.

Section 4. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof in the Recorder's Court, be punished by a fine of not less than \$2.50 nor more than \$15.00, or by imprisonment in the Town Jail for not less than one day nor more than 5 days.

Section 5. All ordinances or part of ordinances in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.
