

ORDINANCE NO. ~~278~~ 282

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF REAL PROPERTY TO AND EXTENDING THE CITY LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF STAYTON AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STAYTON

Section 1. That Whereas a petition was filed by all the property owners of the hereinafter described and bounded property and that pursuant to said petition and in compliance with Chapter 563 Oregon Laws 1951, the Common Council of the Town of Stayton, by resolution, passed March 2, 1953, set a date for hearing of objections to said petition and annexation for April 6, 1953, at 8 o'clock P. M.

That notice of said hearing stating time and place were published in the Stayton Mail, a newspaper of general circulation in said town, and four copies of said notices were posted in four conspicuous places one of which being the City Bulletin Board at the City Hall, Town of Stayton, Oregon.

There being no objects offered at or on the date of hearing, the Common Council of the Town of Stayton found that such annexation was necessary and directed the City Recorder to prepare an Ordinance annexing the property set forth in the petition to the Town of Stayton and extending the City limits to so include the same.

Section 2. That it is hereby declared that the following described real property is hereby annexed to the Town of Stayton and the City limits of the Town are hereby extended to include the same.

Beginning on the Section line common to Sections 10 and 11, Township 9 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, Marion County, Oregon, said point being 863.58 feet North of the quarter section corner between sections 10 and 11 of said Township and Range; thence North  $89^{\circ} 09'$  East 1386.00 feet to the East line of a tract of land conveyed to Amandus J. Frank and Louise Frank, by deed recorded in Volume 429, Page 219, Deed Records for Marion County, Oregon; thence North along the East line of said tract 900.00 feet to the Northeast corner of said tract; thence South  $89^{\circ} 09'$  West along the North line of said tract 92.40 feet to the Southeast corner of a tract of land conveyed to George H. Bell and Abbie M. Bell by deed recorded in Volume 429, Page 542, Deed Records for Marion County, Oregon; thence North  $0^{\circ} 05'$  East along the East line of said tract 875.16 feet to the Northeast corner

of said tract on the North line of Section 11 in said Township and Range; thence South 89° 09' West along the North line of said Section 1294.26 feet to the corner common to Sections 2,3, 10 and 11 in said Township and Range; thence South on the Section line common to Sections 10 and 11 in said Township and Range 1775.16 feet to the place of beginning.

Section 3. That it is necessary that this property be added to the Town of Stayton for fire protection and water service and therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be and become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption by the Common Council of the Town of Stayton and approval by the Mayor.
