

ORDINANCE NO 453

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 450. relating to Assessments on West Kathy Street and North Holly Avenue.

THE CITY OF STAYTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 Section 1 of Ordinance number 450, entitled "AN ORDINANCE declaring assessments on property benefited, for the cost of construction paving on West Kathy Street, from West Regis Street northerly and easterly to the end and Westerly to North Douglas Street and North Holly Avenue from Water Street to Ida Street, in the City of Stayton, Oregon; and directing the City Recorder to enter such assessments against each lot, part of lot and parcel of land benefited therefor in its proportionate share in the lien docket of the City of Stayton; directing the service of notice of said assessments upon the owners of such property, and declaring an amergency" shall be henceforth be amended and read as follows:
