

ORDINANCE NO. 321

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Charter of the City of Stayton, Marion County, Oregon, for the purpose of enlarging the legally described boundary of the City of Stayton, Marion County, Oregon by annexing the following described real property, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the legal subdivision line running East and West through the middle of Section 11, in Township 9 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, in Marion County, Oregon, and 21.00 chains North 89°11' East from the quarter section corner between Sections 10 and 11, in said Township and Range; thence North 89° 11' East 9.37 chains along the legal subdivision running East and West through the middle of said Section 11; thence North 26.687 chains; thence South 89° 0' West 9.37 chains; thence South 26.68 chains to the place of beginning.

By authorizing the Common Council to call a public hearing where said proposed annexation will be placed before the registered voters of the City of Stayton, Marion County, Oregon, so that their comments may be heard, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON:

Section 1. That a special election for the proposed annexation is unnecessary; the written consent of two-thirds of the land owners in the said area representing two-thirds of the assessed valuation of said area having been submitted to the Common Council.

Section 2. That a public hearing will be held at 8:30 o'clock P. M. on the 6th day of May, 1963, at the City Hall, 398 N. Third Avenue, Stayton, Marion County, Oregon, for the purpose of placing before the registered voters of said city the said proposed annexation to the City of Stayton, Marion County, Oregon, of the following real property, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the legal subdivision line running East and West through the middle of Section 11, in Township 9 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, in Marion County, Oregon, and 21.00 chains North 89° 11' East from the quarter section corner between Sections 10 and 11, in said Township and Range;


thence North 89° 11' East 9.37 chains along the legal subdivision running East and West through the middle of said Section 11; thence North 26.687 chains; thence South 89° 0' West 9.37 chains, thence South 26.68 chains to the place of beginning.

Section 3. That the City Attorney is hereby directed to prepare and have published "Notice of Public Hearing" in The Stayton Mail, a newspaper of general circulation, once a week for two successive weeks prior to the hearing, as well as having said notice posted the same length of time in four (4) public places, including the bulletin board at the City Hall.



It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions in the City of Stayton, Marion County, Oregon, are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
