

ORDINANCE NO. 358

Amending Section 12 of Ordinance No. 300 of the City of Stayton, relating to the construction of sidewalks and curbs; authorizing liens for unpaid costs of curb construction; and declaring an emergency.

THE CITY OF STAYTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 12 of Ordinance No. 300 of the City of Stayton is amended to read:

Section 12. Each lot or part thereof, or parcel of land shall be liable for the full cost of the construction of such sidewalk in front of and abutting upon it, extending to the curb lines, and provided, further, that if such assessment is not paid after notice thereof, the council may proceed to levy upon such lot or part thereof, or parcel of land, liable for such assessment, and cause the lien thereof to be satisfied by execution and sale, in the manner provided by the charter of the City of Stayton for the collection of delinquent assessments for the improvement of streets. The word "lien" and the docketing and satisfying thereof, as applied to sidewalks herein, shall apply also to curbs.

Section 2. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the city of Stayton and the inhabitants thereof and an emergency hereby is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
