ORDINANCE NO. 366

An Ordinance levying a special property tax of \$2,000 per year outside the constitutional six percent limitation for a period of three years beginning with the fiscal year 1967-68, to provide funds to pay the cost of facilities, equipment, programming, and the services of personnel for recreational purposes within the City of Stayton; submitting such ordinance to the legal voters of the City of Stayton for their approval or rejection at a special city election to be held APRIL 18, 1967; and declaring an emergency.

THE CITY OF STAYTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. To provide funds to pay the cost of facilities, equipment, programming, and the services of personnel for recreational purposes within the City of Stayton, and for no other purpose, the Council each year for a period of three consecutive years, beginning with the fiscal year 1967-68, shall levy a special property tax of \$2,000 per year outside the limitation imposed by Article XI, Section 11, of the Constitution of the State of Oregon. The proceeds of such tax levies and such interest as may accrue thereon shall be set aside by the City Recorder in a "Recreation Fund" separate and distinct from other funds of the city.

Section 2. As provided by ORS 280.080 the Council estimates that the total outlay for the purposes of this ordinance, including clerical and administrative costs for the three years indicated in Section 1 hereof, will be the sum of \$6,000.

Section 3. This Ordinance is submitted to the legal voters

of the City of Stayton for their approval or rejection at a special city election hereby called to be held between the hours of 8:00 o'clock a.m. and 8:00 o'clock p.m. on APRIL 18, 1967.

Section 4. The following ballot title prepared by the City Attorney under which this ordinance shall be submitted to the voters of the city, is hereby approved and adopted:

The Recorder is hereby instructed and directed to post and

publish notices of such election in the manner provided by Ordinance No. 242 of such city and to furnish to the election board for such election the necessary records, ballot boxes, tally sheets, and supplies for such election.

Section 6. Such election shall be conducted in accordance with the election laws of the State of Oregon and with the Charter and pertinent Ordinances of such city. Upon approval by the voters of such ordinance the Mayor, in conformity with said Ordinance No. 242, shall issue his proclamation declaring the result of such election.

Section 7. It is hereby adjudged and declared that since the three-year serial levy of such city for recreational purposes heretofore authorized and made will expire during the current fiscal year and no other funds are or will be available for such purposes during the next three fiscal years, and since existing conditions in such City are such that further tax funds are necessary for such purposes and this ordinance is necessary for the peace, health, safety, and general welfare of such City and its inhabitants, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
