

ORDINANCE NO. 96.

A Bill for an Ordinance to extend Water Street in the Town of Stayton, Oregon, from First Street West to the East Boundary Line of S. H. Burson's Addition to the Town of Stayton.

THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STAYTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That certain piece of land heretofore deeded to the Town of Stayton, by the heirs of Leander Brown, deceased, and by J. J. Stehly and Katie Stehly, his wife, and described as follows:

Commencing at a point one-hundred and ninety-six feet and two inches (196' 2") North of the quarter section corner between sections 10 and 15, in Township 9 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, in Marion County, Oregon, running thence West 898 feet to the East boundary line of S. H. Burson's Addition to the Town of Stayton; thence South along said boundary line 50 feet; thence East 898 feet; thence North 50 feet to the place of beginning. is hereby ordained, declared and dedicated a public street; and shall be known as West Water Street, and shall (be) maintained and improved the same as other streets are maintained and improved.

Section 2. As there is need of immediate improvements on said street, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on and after its approval.
