

ORDINANCE NO. 536

ORDERING CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS ON CERTAIN PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF STAYTON.

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Stayton deems it necessary and in the best interest of the public to construct a concrete sidewalk along certain property in the City of Stayton, and;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 4.340 of the Stayton Code;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON:

Section 1. The sidewalk shall be constructed in accordance with plans and standard specifications of the City. Said sidewalk shall be constructed at the expense of the abutting property owners and property owners on the southeast side of Highland Drive, covered by agreement previously signed with the City, proportionately to the number of feet they have on the front. If said sidewalk is not constructed within sixty (60) days from the date of notice of this Resolution, the City shall cause the sidewalk to be constructed as provided in Code Section 4.350.

Section 2. In the event it becomes necessary to construct the sidewalk in accordance with Section 4.350, the abutting property owners and property owners on the southeast side of Highland Dr., covered by agreement previously signed with the City, shall be liable for the full amount assessed against said property.

Section 3. The sidewalk ordered constructed by this Resolution is located as follows:

The northwest side of Highland Drive fronting Lot 5, Block 6,  
Highland Estates No. 2

Section 4. The City Administrator is hereby empowered to notify the affected property owners, by certified mail, of the substance of this Resolution and post a copy of this Resolution in a conspicuous place upon the affected property for a period of at least ten (10) days.
