

RESOLUTION NO. 815

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF STAYTON TO APPLY FOR A TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT GRANT FROM THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO IMPROVE MARION STREET BETWEEN FIRST AND FOURTH AVENUES, AS DESCRIBED IN THE ADOPTED DOWNTOWN TRANSPORTATION AND REVITALIZATION PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department Transportation (ODOT) is accepting applications for the Transportation Enhancement Grant Program;

WHEREAS, the Stayton Downtown Transportation and Revitalization Plan adopted in October 2007, identifies pedestrian and storm water improvements to Marion Street between the Community Center Park and Pioneer Park;

WHEREAS, the City of Stayton desires to participate in this matching grant program to the greatest extent possible as a resource for implementing the Downtown Plan and making improvements to the pedestrian environment and linking two important public recreational resources;

WHEREAS, the Transportation Enhancement grant requires a 10.27% match (\$55,000) from the City of Stayton;

WHEREAS, a requirement of the ODOT grant application process is that the application include an approved resolution from the governing body authorizing the grant application.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Stayton, through its City Administrator, shall apply for a Transportation Grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation for a grant of \$475,000 for improvements to Marion Street, between First Avenue and Fourth Avenue as identified in the Downtown Transportation and Revitalization Plan.

This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption by the Stayton City Council.
