

RESOLUTION NO. 875

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET FOR THE
2010-2011 FISCAL YEAR**

WHEREAS, after the budget process for the 2010-2011 fiscal year was completed, an occurrence or condition arose that could not have been ascertained at the time of the budget preparation;

WHEREAS, Marion County building permit pass through dollars in excess of the appropriation approved for the 2010-2011 fiscal budget year, the additional appropriations needed is more than ten percent of the annual budget; and,

WHEREAS, in order to lawfully comply with the requirements of Local Budget Law, a supplemental budget is necessary; and,

WHEREAS, Oregon Revised Statutes 294.480 allows for the preparation and adoption of a supplemental budget;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council wishes to comply with Local Budget Law and adopt a supplemental budget for the 2010-2011 fiscal year; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that 63.33.49500 (Miscellaneous Revenue) and 63.80.59999 (Miscellaneous Expenditures) should be increased by \$320,000;


This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption by the Stayton City Council.


