

RESOLUTION No. 648

RESOLUTION ASSIGNING IMPOUNDMENT AND DISPOSITION OF VEHICLE FEES WITHIN THE CITY OF STAYTON.

WHEREAS, the Stayton City Council has adopted changes in the Stayton Municipal Code (hereafter "SMC) governing Impoundment and Disposition of Vehicles [(SMC Chapter 10.16.400(3)], to better accommodate the use of personnel time and materials;

WHEREAS, in conjunction with the SMC 10.16.400(3) "IMPOUNDMENT AND DISPOSITION OF VEHICLES: GENERAL REGULATIONS" amendment, the Council amended SMC 10.44.1110(4) "SPECIFIC PENALTIES", as the specific penalties referenced therein are better declared, from time to time, by Council Resolution; and,

WHEREAS, as it is fair and reasonable that the City need to set fees sufficient to recover the cost in personnel time and materials to render the services requested, the Council deems that the appropriate charges are reflected in this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that:

Violation of any provision of Stayton Municipal Code Section 10.16.400 "IMPOUNDMENT AND DISPOSITION OF VEHICLES: GENERAL REGULATIONS" is an infraction and punishable by a forfeiture not to exceed the cost of the towing bill, a \$125.00 impoundment fee, and, if the vehicle is stored in the City's impound lot, a storage fee in the amount of \$15.00 per day commencing at 00:01 hours on the day following the impoundment of the vehicle.

This Resolution becomes effective upon the effective date of Ordinance 806, which amends SMC 10.44.1110(4) wherein SPECIFIC PENALTIES are to be hence forth addressed by the Council Resolution.
