

RESOLUTION NO. 513

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING FEES AND CHARGES FOR LIBRARY SERVICES.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 496 classifies fees, charges, and bonded indebtedness as being subject or not being subject to the property tax limitations of Section 11(b), Article XI, of the Oregon Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the City of Stayton has determined that library fees and charges are not subject to the property tax limitations of the Oregon Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the City of Stayton receives requests from citizens for administrative, library, and recreational services requiring the expenditure of personnel time and materials; and

WHEREAS, the City of Stayton needs to charge fees sufficient to recover the cost in personnel time and materials to render the service requested; and

WHEREAS, it is found that current fees for library services are inadequate to recover those costs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Stayton City Council that the following fees will be charged for library services:

Lost or damaged books	Cost of repair or replacement plus 10 percent
Overdue Charges	10 cents per day
Out-of-District User Fees	\$30 per year
