

RESOLUTION NO. 400

STATE OF OREGON
THREE PERCENT TELEPHONE EXCISE TAX

WHEREAS, ORS 401.710 to 401.790 provides for the establishment of 9-1-1 service and system requirements; and

WHEREAS, ORS provides for a tax equal to three (3) percent, which is imposed on the telephone subscriber; and

WHEREAS, the tax shall sunset on December 31, 1991; and

WHEREAS, 9-1-1 tax revenues are integral to the 9-1-1 operation and financial stability of the CITY OF STAYTON and SANTIAM CANYON COMMUNICATIONS COUNCIL;


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Stayton City Council supports the continuation of 9-1-1 service and supports any legislative action required for continuance of the three (3) percent telephone excise tax.
