

RESOLUTION NO. 434

A RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING RECEIPT OF GRANT FUND FROM THE FRED MEYER CHARITABLE TRUST AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION.

WHEREAS, Oregon Local Budget Law, under ORS 294.326(2), provides that money from an unanticipated grant which has been transferred to a municipal corporation in trust for a specific purpose may be lawfully expended after enactment of an appropriation resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City of Stayton has received grant funds from the Fred Meyer Charitable Trust for the 1989-1990 fiscal year in the amount of \$7,500.00 for equipment for the Stayton Public Library;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY OF STAYTON adopts this resolution in the full amount of \$7,500.00 and for the purpose shown below and is hereby appropriated as follows:

Capital Outlay (Equipment)	\$7,500.00




